You Must Include a Copy of the Rabies Certificate; Please Note:

In order for the license to be issued the owner must present proof that a licensed veterinarian has vaccinated the CAT against rabies and that the duration of immunity from that vaccination extends through at least ten (10) months of the twelve (12) month licensing period. **BETWEEN JUNE 1 AND MARCH 30, 2022**

1. Cats are required to be licensed by the age of seven (7) months.
2. An exemption to the rabies inoculation requirement shall be granted if the owner presents written certification from a licensed Veterinarian that the CAT cannot be vaccinated due to a medical condition or course of therapy.
3. There is no late fee for newly acquired CATS or new residents. However, owners are required to license all CATS **within (10) days** of acquisition and/or establishing new residency in the Township.
