Acceptable Recycling Items

- Plastic bags may ***not*** be used as recycling containers and will not be picked up!
- Newspapers and magazines (NOT TIED).
- Junk mail, mixed paper, paperboard, and cardboard placed in recycling container. Shredded paper ONLY may be placed in transparent plastic bags (not black).
- Corrugated cardboard boxes flattened. No oil-stained pizza boxes.
- Commingled glass bottles and jars. Please remove lids and rinse prior to recycling. Material should be CLEAN, DRY, and EMPTY
- Commingled metal cans (aluminum, steel, or tin). Please rinse out all cans.
- Plastic bottles/ tubs with a recycling code or symbol marked #1, #2, and #5 ONLY i.e., soda bottles, milk and detergent containers, yogurt and sour cream containers. Milk, juice and soup stock cartons as well as juice boxes (not pouches) can be placed in your commingled container.

- Window glass/ broken glass
- Mirrors & light bulbs
- Ceramics & dishes
- Clay flower pots

Plastic

- Bags, straws, cups
- Toys
- Food trays & utensils
- PPE (gloves, masks)

Waxed or Coated Paper

- Styrofoam
- Ice cream containers
- Pizza boxes

Aluminum

- Aluminum foil & pie tins
- Clothes hangers
- Pots & pans
