Dear residents,

The Jefferson Township Water Utility is required to compile a materials survey for all service lines in the water system. It is part of the Lead and Copper Sampling Program, to catalogue each residence's service line material, as well as locating any residences that could have a water service line made of lead. We currently have no knowledge of any lead service lines existing in our system(s), as they are very often associated with homes that are over 100 years old.

The water utility would like to ensure that our records are accurate and up to date, and that we are currently in compliance with all State and Federal regulations. At this time, the Township would like to ask each resident who is connected to the public water system, to call or email our office with the type of service line your home currently contains. Under most circumstances, the service line is made of copper or plastic. The utility is also aware of service lines installed with galvanized steel, but these are encountered less frequently.

Each resident is asked to send an email to jperry@jeffersontownship.net, with your address in the title line, stating what material your individual service line is/was constructed with. All residents are also encouraged to include a photograph of the service line entering the home. This will assist us in properly identifying each residence's service line materials, and also assist residents who are unsure of what type of material it is constructed with. You can also call our office at (973) 208-6144 to report the result of your materials evaluation, or leave a message. If you leave a message, we ask that you please include your address in it. We thank everyone in advance for your cooperation on this matter.
